

GLOBAL FUTURE CITIES ALLIANCE. ACCESSION AGREEMENT.

ARTICLE 1, OVERVIEW OF THE ALLIANCE

Name

Global Future Cities Alliance.

Positioning

The Global future cities alliance (GFCA) is an international communication and cooperation platform for smart city operation services, and is a non-profit international organization approved by the U.S. government. The GFCA will unite more national politics, the production, study and research, from all walks of life to create standard research development, technology advancement, industry chain cooperation, personnel training, investment and financing in the integration of global normal communication platform for the trust, advancing the global wisdom city operating mode, experience and resources sharing.

Purpose

Establish the model of future city with international influence through the global resources. Set up platform for industry introduction + innovation incubation pair with the global resources, market, talent, technology, service and international cooperation. Create the future of urban ecological system, intelligent application service platform and operation service standards, to power cities innovation and economy development.

Members

They will be including domestic and foreign NGOs, government agencies, research institutes, enterprises and institutions, investment and financing institutions, etc.

Guidance

GFCA accepts the business guidance and supervision and management of China service trade association. Head office of the GFCA secretariat is in Los Angeles.

Work content

Set industry standards, organize conference activities, promote researches, talent training and talent acquisition, awards shows, innovation incubation fund support, etc.

ARTICLE 2, RESPONSIBILITY OF THE AGREEMENT.

All enterprises, institutions, scientific research institutions, etc. that have accepted the "Global Future Cities Alliance Charter" and signed an agreement are regarded as members of the Alliance, and they have the rights and commitments in the Articles of Association.

ARTICLE 3, RIGHTS

1. The right to vote, to be elected and to vote as a member of the Alliance;

2. The right to criticize and advise on the work of the coalition;
3. Participate in related activities of the coalition organization;
4. Priority or preferential access to member services of the Alliance and books, materials, etc.;
5. Voluntary participation and withdrawal from freedom.

ARTICLE 4, OBLIGATIONS TO PERFORM

1. Abide by the constitution of the alliance, executive council resolution;
2. Committed to promoting alliance construction;
3. Maintain the legitimate rights and interests of the alliance;
4. Actively participate in and support the activities of the alliance.

ARTICLE 5, WITHDRAWAL FROM THE ALLIANCE

1. In the following cases, member units will be required to withdraw from the coalition:

- 1) Serious violation of the constitution of the alliance and this agreement;
- 2) Seriously undermining the rights and interests of coalition members;
- 3) Failing to perform the obligations of the coalition members;

The Union will issue a written notice to the relevant member units stating the reasons for the termination and the effective time.

2. Affiliate withdrawals shall be notified in writing to the Alliance Secretariat and no longer enjoy all the rights and services provided by the Alliance.
